But Kim's controlling 'mumager' has been working overtime to defend her daughter's reputation, while promoting her new memoir, *Kris Jenner... And All Things Kardashian*, of course. At time of press, Kim was back in LA before heading cross country again to shoot the ironically titled *The Marriage Counselor*, despite the film's director Tyler Perry coming under fire for casting the now-controversial star. And she remained in damage control mode, reportedly writing emails to her father's side of the family, apologising for 'jumping the gun' on her marriage. 'Kris is a great guy but we come from such different worlds and he isn't what I thought when we 1st met,' she wrote. 'I'm embarrassed that I took everyone on this journey with me and had this huge wedding. But I have

to be happy, so I have to let this relationship go.'

However, Kris isn't about to give up. Despite reports that he asked for the \$2 million engagement ring back,

those close to the basketballer say he just wants to win Kim back and was 'ecstatic' at the chance to do so during their meeting. 'I'm committed to this marriage,' he says. 'I love my wife.'

Kris Jenner says the couple needs privacy and for the public to withhold their judgment. 'People really need to listen and just be patient and wait for everything to reveal itself.'

But by the time the answers come – in the upcoming season of *Keeping Up with the Kardashians*, no doubt – who will be watching? **OK!**

## Kim turns to plastic surgery?

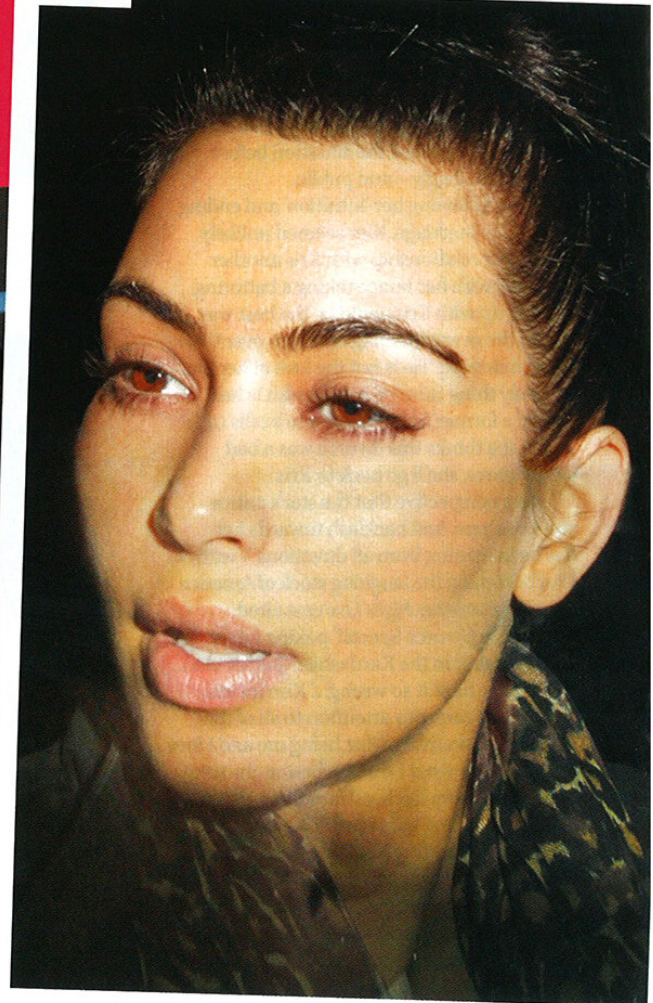
**B**are-faced after her stressful visit to Minnesota to see Kris, Kim raised eyebrows with her extremely taut and wrinkle-free face as she arrived back in LA on November 7. Has the recent turmoil in her private life sent the reality star into a panic over her looks? She's been open about her Botox use in the past and has always said she has no issues with cosmetic surgery – 'I would never judge anyone else for getting any kind of surgical or non-surgical procedure,' she says – and according to Dr Joseph Hkeik at All Saints Cosmedical Clinic, Kim appears to have had a last-minute top-up.
